Resheph

Resheph was a deity associated with plague, war, and sometimes thunder in ancient Canaanite religion. The originally Eblaite and Canaanite god was then more famously adopted into ancient Egyptian religion in the late Bronze Age during the Eighteenth Dynasty of Egypt, also becoming associated with horses and chariots. In Biblical Hebrew, רשף resheph is a noun interpreted as "flame, lightning" but also "burning fever, plague, pestilence".
