Statistically, the vast majority of flights operate without incident. The incidents we hear about represent an extraordinarily small fraction of the millions of flights that take off each year. Second, crashes involving smaller, private planes have been happening long before January 20th, but the current heightened concerns around air travel, paired with high-profile incidents like the ones in Toronto and D.C., have led to more coverage and awareness.

Now, let's take a thorough look at the state of American aviation right now. I'm diving into the details and offering insights that aren't typically covered in mainstream media. In a recent development, the Trump administration has begun firing hundreds of Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) employees, including those working in critical areas like radar systems, landing support, and navigational aid maintenance. These terminations, which took place over the President's Day weekend, have sparked concerns about the impact on

air safety, particularly amid existing staffing shortages in the FAA. The National Air Traffic Controllers Association has expressed alarm about the potential risks posed by these firings, as the employees involved play vital roles in ensuring smooth and safe flight operations.

January 29, 2025: First Commercial Plane Crash in 16 Years in Washington D.C.

- **Event:** A mid-air collision occurred near Washington D.C., involving an American Airlines passenger plane and a U.S. Army Black Hawk helicopter.
- **Details:** On January 29, 2025, a mid-air collision occurred near Washington, D.C., involving an American Airlines regional jet and a U.S. Army Black Hawk helicopter. The crash resulted in the deaths of all 67 individuals on board both aircraft. The American Airlines flight, operating as Flight 5342, was a Bombardier CRJ700 regional jet en route from Wichita, Kansas, to Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport. The Black Hawk helicopter, registered as 87-24707, was conducting a routine training flight for the U.S. Army's 12th Aviation Battalion. The collision occurred over the Potomac River, near the airport, leading to the tragic loss of life.

January 31, 2025: Learjet Crash in Philadelphia

- **Event:** A Learjet 55, operated by Jet Rescue Air Ambulance, crashed in the Castor Gardens neighborhood of Philadelphia.
- **Details:** On January 31, 2025, Med Jets Flight 056, a Learjet 55 air ambulance, crashed shortly after takeoff from Northeast Philadelphia Airport. The aircraft, on a medical flight to Tijuana, Mexico, was carrying six individuals, including a young patient and her mother, as well as four crew members. Tragically, all aboard

perished. The crash caused fires and explosions, claiming one life on the ground and injuring at least 24 others. Weather conditions at the time included light rain, fog, and gusty winds, which may have contributed to the accident. The cause of the crash is under investigation.

February 5, 2025: Japan Airlines Plane Strikes Delta Flight on Runway in Seattle

- **Event:** A Japan Airlines flight collided with a parked Delta Air Lines plane at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.
- **Details:** On February 5, 2025, at approximately 10:15 a.m., a Japan Airlines aircraft, while taxiing at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, collided with the tail of a stationary Delta Air Lines plane. The incident occurred on the ramp between the S Concourse and the south airport maintenance hangars. No injuries were reported among the passengers or crew of either flight. However, the collision, combined with winter weather conditions, led to over 170 flight delays and some cancellations that day.

February 6, 2025: Bering Air Flight Wrecks in Nome, Alaska

- **Event:** Bering Air Flight 445, a Cessna 208B Grand Caravan, crashed into sea ice near Nome, Alaska.
- **Details:** On February 6, 2025, Bering Air Flight 445, a Cessna 208B, crashed into sea ice 34 miles southeast of Nome, Alaska, killing all 10 people on board. The flight, which was traveling from Unalakleet Airport to Nome Airport, disappeared during its journey, and the wreckage was located after extensive search efforts. The passengers included both Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium employees,

who were on a work mission, as well as other community members. The crash is under investigation, with weather conditions and a rapid loss of elevation potentially contributing to the accident.

February 10, 2025: Plane Crashes in Scottsdale, AZ

- **Event:** A small business jet, owned by Vince Neil, crashed into a parked Gulfstream 2100 business jet at Scottsdale Airport.
- **Details:** On February 10, 2025, a Learjet 35A, owned by Mötley Crüe singer Vince Neil, veered off the runway at Scottsdale Airport in Arizona and collided with a parked Gulfstream 200 jet. The crash resulted in the death of the Learjet's pilot, 78-year-old Marine veteran Joie Vitosky, and injuries to three others, including Neil's girlfriend, Rain Andreani, who sustained five broken ribs. Neil was not on the plane at the time of the incident. The National Transportation Safety Board is investigating the cause of the crash, with initial reports indicating a failure in the Learjet's left main landing gear upon landing.

February 12, 2025: Military Fighter Jet Crashes into San Diego Bay

- **Event:** An EA-18G Growler electronic warfare jet crashed into San Diego Bay.
- **Details:** On February 12, 2025, at approximately 10:15 a.m., a U.S. Navy EA-18G Growler fighter jet crashed into San Diego Bay during a "go-around" maneuver near Naval Air Station North Island. Both pilots ejected safely before the crash and were rescued by a nearby fishing boat. They were subsequently transported to a hospital in stable condition. The incident occurred in misty and rainy

conditions, and the aircraft plunged nose-first into the water, creating a significant plume. An investigation is underway to determine the cause of the crash.

February 16, 2025: Plane Crashes in Covington, GA

- **Event:** A small plane crashed near Covington Municipal Airport, resulting in two fatalities.
- **Details:** On February 16, 2025, a small single-engine plane, a Rockwell Commander, crashed shortly after taking off from Covington Municipal Airport in Newton County, Georgia, killing the two people on board. The plane, which had taken off around 11:20 p.m., lost communication with air traffic control shortly afterward. The wreckage was found in the woods near the runway, and both victims, identified as Janet Hardee, 59, and James Hardee, 62, were pronounced dead at the scene. The crash is under investigation by the FAA and the National Transportation Safety Board.

February 17, 2025: Delta Plane Crashes Upon Landing In Toronto, Canada

- **Event:** A Delta airplane experienced a crash landing at the Toronto Airport, flipping upside down during landing.
- **Details:** On February 17, 2025, Delta Air Lines Flight 4819, a Bombardier CRJ-900, crashed upon landing at Toronto Pearson International Airport, flipping upside down on the runway. The flight, originating from Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport, had approximately 80 people on board. Emergency crews responded promptly, and all passengers and crew were accounted

for, with at least eight individuals reported injured. The crash occurred following a heavy winter storm that deposited nearly nine inches of snow at the airport, requiring overnight efforts to clear the runways. The incident is under investigation by the National Transportation Safety Board.

From what I've researched, a little of both. There has been a slight uptick in plane accidents (crashes and other problems) but we don't as of yet have enough data to say if it is an actual statistical increase or if it's within the normal margin of fluctuation. However, what accidents have occurred are getting much more media attention due to the FAA firings (which, from what I understand, have been linked as a contributing factor in at least one of the crashes (Washington DC)).

The last numbers I saw were a 2-7% increase in reported plane incidents since Trump took office, but that is far too small a number over far too short a time to really determine if there is an overall trend here.
